14 th August	1 day seminar Christchurch	Common Cue Combinations and Sequences and International Cue Combinations and Sequences Revisit the fundamentals of a motion based handling system that are often the root cause for errors even at the International level, while also learning how to apply those fundamentals in unique and challenging situations similar to those commonly seen on International Style courses. Transitions typically occur with more frequency and speed on an International course, so you will be challenged mentally and physically to be where you need to be to use motion to guide your dog through a course. The focus will be on handling, so primarily turning obstacles will be used (jumps, tunnels, and chutes).
